Also on Wednesdays you may attend the "Miscellaneous Sale", a huge auction with as many as 12 auctioneers working at the same time, a must see experience.

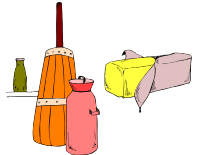
